Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

Our warm greetings to you all in the name of Him whom we serve. This is an update of the Cebu Rural Christian Mission of the Rev. and Mrs. Alejandro L. Bingtan, year 2012-2013.

1.) STUDENTS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

This year we have twenty three scholars, twenty two of them are enjoying a partial scholarship of P 2,000 a year and one is full scholarship in the person of Rutchel Medello, a first year college student.

Last June, we have distributed to our scholars, one hundred notebooks, pencils, ball pens, bags for the new students and a cash of P500 each for our twenty two scholars. Last September 9, 2012, during our Sabalumpart visitation at Basak UCCP, the second release of P500 was made. Mrs. Erlina Bingtan and myself had a plan that the third release will be on the first week of December before Christmas time.

Last March, four of our scholars have graduated in college. They are from Paril Church Tag-angilan.

Edissa Mabini and Jean Gervise are preparing for their Board Exam this coming October. We hope and pray that they will pass the Board Exam. Joelisa Bingtan and Edissa Mabini are already employed now.

11.) SAC-ON KINDERGARTEN SCHOOL

We have only ten children here in our school, ages three and four. All children who are five years old are all enrolled in Public school. But we're happy to continue the work even if they are only small in number. The children's parents are happy helping me in preparing the food

everyday. Thanks to Our Mission Partners for the Children's Feeding Program and to the teacher's salary assistance. Financial donation coming from Dany & Trini Miniano for the School's Feeding Program. Thanks for their gift of love to the children. Cash gift from Mr. & Mrs. Keith & Marian Conning, Thank you so much for your help.

111.) PASTORS SALARY ASSISTANCE

This salary assistance to pastors assigned in the mountain area. Three are assigned in Sabalumpart Circuit and one in District 1. This is really great help to the Pastors working in these area where members are so poor and seldom can get a full pastor to work with them.


